

## BP 2720 COMMUNICATIONS AMONG BOARD MEMBERS

## **Reference:**

Government Code Section 54952.2

In accordance with the Brown Act (Government Code Sections 54950 et seq.), members of the Board shall not communicate among themselves by the use of any form of communication (e.g., personal intermediaries, e-mail, or other technological device) in order to reach a collective concurrence regarding any item that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Board. In addition, no other person shall make serial communications to Board Members for the purpose of influencing a decision.
