

BP 2735 BOARD MEMBER TRAVEL

Education Code Section 72423 Government Code Section 11139.8

Board members, including the Student Trustee, are encouraged to participate in professional conferences and meetings that increase and enhance their understanding of the community college mission and the role of trustees, including serving as advocates for and representatives of the District.

The District shall reimburse the reasonable expenses incurred by Board Members in authorized travel to appropriate conferences and professional meetings related to their Board responsibilities.

With respect to participation in professional conferences and meetings related to their Board responsibilities, Board Members shall not travel to any state identified by the California Attorney General that has enacted a law that authorizes or requires discrimination against same-sex couples or their family members or on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression. Some exceptions apply as outlined in Government Code § 11139.8.
