

BP 4100 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES

References:

Education Code Sections 66746-66749 and 70902(b)(3); Title 5 Sections 55060 et seq.

The District grants the following degrees: Associate in Arts; Associate in Science; Associate in Arts, Transfer; and Associate in Science, Transfer. In addition, the District grants Certificates of Achievement and Certificates of Completion.

The Superintendent/President shall, in collegial consultation with the Academic Senate, establish procedures to set degree and certificate requirements. The procedures shall require that graduation requirements are published in the catalog and included in other resources that are accessible to students.

Catalog Rights

Catalog rights permit students who are continuously enrolled at the institution to select the catalog year the student will follow for general education and degree/certificate requirements provided the catalog selected is one of the following:

- 1. the catalog in effect at the time of initial enrollment;
- 2. the catalog in effect at the time of graduation; or
- 3. any catalog year between initial enrollment and graduation

Such catalog rights do not preclude a department from requiring recency requirements established through the Curriculum Advisory Committee process.
