

AP 5012 INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Education Code Sections 76141 and 76142; Title 5 Section 54045; Title 8, U.S. Code Sections 1101. et seq.

The District may admit international students.

International students who seek admission must satisfy the following conditions:

- 1. Submission of the District's International Student Application.
- 2. Submission of high school grade reports and, if applicable, English language program transcripts and all other college or university grade reports.
- 3. Submission of confidential financial statement and bank certification letter showing proof of sufficient funds to cover a minimum of one year of studies.
- 4. Submission of a copy of valid passport.
- 5. F-1 students must purchase the medical insurance plan, which is approved by the District.

The District notifies eligible international students of their acceptance by providing students with an official acceptance letter and by issuing an I-20 Certificate of Eligibility for Non-Immigrant (F-1) Student Status for Academic and Language Students.

F-1 Visa students are required to maintain full-time status for the duration of their studies.

International students are required to maintain the same standard of scholarship as other students and are subject to the same rules of academic standing (e.g. probation and disqualification).
