Summary: All CAEP SBAEC programs continue to serve adult learners fully online with the exception of the Workforce who currently meet with clients in-person and online. The Adults with Disabilities and Goleta Valley Library temporarily limited programming in fall 2020 and are making revisions to their programs for spring 2021. The Noncredit English as a Second Language program has seen an increase in enrollment in some courses which indicates that accessibility in the online model has proven successful. The CAEP SBAEC Emergency Funding allocated to programs in June 2020 has also proven successful by assisting programs to purchase hardware for their learners that would not have been possible without these funds.
